Reported COVID-19 Deaths and Recoveries:

Regrettably, we report a further **74** COVID-19 related deaths: 39 from Western Cape, 31 from the Eastern Cape, and 4 from North West.

This brings the total national deaths to **1284** with a mortality rate of 2,2%.

We extend our condolences to the loved ones of the departed and thank the health care workers who treated the deceased.

The recoveries to date are **33 252**- this translates to a recovery rate of 56,8%.
